



Subcommittee #5 Meeting Notes  
November 11, 2015 from 1:30-2:30 PM  
Ottawa County Department of Public Health

2. Discussion of expansion:
  - a. The group talked through some options for next summer. After some discussion about what is possible from Hand 2 Hand and the needs that currently exist at Pine Acres, we would like to hold off on Holiday West until 2017.
  - b. Karen will talk with the Hand 2 Hand churches to find out who is willing to help support Pine Acres (and possibly Leisure Estates if needed) in 2016 and would be willing to step up and spearhead efforts for the summer of 2017.
  - c. Amy will talk with Austin about the possibility of a pilot site at Holiday West in 2016 to see what the interest in at that location. This was done in Grand Haven this past summer and worked really well. If Austin cannot provide a staff person to the site for the pilot, we will hold off on this idea.
  - d. We will re-group in 2016 and hope to discuss ways to strengthen existing partnerships and resources. We hope to engage Boys and Girls Club and other Holland Meet Up and Eat Up sites.
3. As a reminder – we're so thankful to all of you for the incredible growth we saw this past year at our summer meal sites. In 2015, 4,909 meals were served at Leisure Estates and 1,158 meals were served at Pine Acres (compared to 412 meals served at Leisure Estates in 2014).
4. We will not meet in December. We will continue to meet on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday of the month in 2016 from 1:30-2:30 at the Department of Public Health.
